## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for an additional
- 3 sentence when a firearm is used in the commission of a crime.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes,
- 8 amended December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended by
- 9 adding a section to read:
- 10 § 1106. Additional mandatory sentence.
- 11 (a) Definition.--As used in this section the word "firearm"
- 12 shall include any pistol, shotgun, rifle, pellet gun, BB gun,
- 13 electronic or taser qun, or any other device capable of
- 14 propelling a projectile at or into another person.
- 15 (b) Use of firearm in commission of offense. -- Any individual
- 16 who uses a firearm in the commission of an offense classified as
- 17 a felony or a misdemeanor and is sentenced to pay a fine under
- 18 section 1101 (relating to fines) or imprisonment under section

- 1 1103 (relating to sentence of imprisonment for felony) or
- 2 <u>section 1104 (relating to sentence of imprisonment for</u>
- 3 <u>misdemeanors</u>) shall, in addition to any fine or imprisonment, be
- 4 <u>sentenced to an additional term of three years in prison, which</u>
- 5 term shall run consecutively with any other prison sentence.
- 6 This additional three-year imprisonment shall not be subject to
- 7 <u>suspension nor shall an individual be eliqible for probation or</u>
- 8 parole during such three years.
