## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, 2 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," 5 providing for a full-time district attorney in certain instances in fifth and sixth class counties, setting his 7 salary and making repeals. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The first paragraph of subsection (g) of section 11 1401, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code, added June 24, 1976 (No.107), is amended to read: 12 13 Section 1401. District Attorney; Qualifications; Eligibility; Compensation. -- \* \* \* 14 15 The commissioners of any county of the third [or fourth] fourth, fifth or sixth class may by ordinance fix the services 17 of the district attorney at full time. Such determination may be 18 made at any time, provided that the determination shall not be made between the first day for the circulation of nominating 19 petitions for the office of district attorney and January of the 20

- 11 is repealed insofar as inconsistent with the provisions of this

- 13 (b) Any other act or part of an act inconsistent with the
- 14 provisions of this act are repealed to the extent of the
- 15 inconsistency.
- 16 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
