- 1 Many of our municipalities are in dire need of expanding
- 2 their sewerage treatment plants or in some cases constructing
- 3 new ones where none exist or where existing ones are outmoded.
- 4 New sewerage collection lines must also be built to accommodate
- 5 those living a distance from the plant. To accomplish these ends
- 6 a great amount of money is needed but the local municipalities
- 7 and the State do not have the funds available.
- 8 Support is needed from the Federal Government; therefore be

- 11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorializes the Congress of the
- 12 United States to act expeditiously on needed legislation to
- 13 financially assist our municipalities in the enlargement,
