- 6 Pennsylvania memorialize President Gerald Ford and the Congress
- 7 of the United States of America to dredge the Susquehanna River
- 8 in the Wyoming Valley area of Pennsylvania to help avoid future
- 9 flood disasters; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 11 President Gerald Ford, to the presiding officers of each House
- 12 of the Congress of the United States and to each Senator and
- 13 Representative from Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United
- 14 States.
