In the House of Representatives, May 18, 1976

1 WHEREAS, Two hundred years ago the roots of our national
2 heritage were established in the City of Philadelphia; and

3 WHEREAS, This historic session of the Pennsylvania General
4 Assembly has exercised its duties today within the City which
5 witnessed the signing of the Declaration of Independence and the
6 adoption of the Constitution of the United States; and

7 WHEREAS, This joint session of the General Assembly within
8 the City of Philadelphia has inspired each member to renew his
9 or her commitment to the spirit of our founding father;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
12 appreciates the courtesy and hospitality extended by the City of
13 Philadelphia to the President of this French Republic, to the
14 General Assembly and to all those visiting the City during 1976
15 to celebrate our Nation's Bicentennial Anniversary; and be it

18 members of the General Assembly who wish to subscribe thereto,

1 and one copy be transmitted to the Mayor of the City of
2 Philadelphia; and another copy be transmitted to the Historical
3 and Museum Commission for permanent display at the William Penn
