SENATOR CIANFRANI, APPROPRIATIONS, AS AMENDED, JULY 8, 1975

AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation to the Trustees of the University of
2 Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
6 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated to the Trustees
7 of the University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1,
8 1975 to June 30, 1976, for the purposes and in the amounts as
9 shown:

1 SCHOOL OF DENTAL MEDICINE..... 500,000

2 Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on
3 account of the appropriations for all items provided in section
4 1, except Doctor of Medicine only, shall be made on the basis of
5 net costs during the fiscal year. Payments for instruction,
6 Doctor of Medicine only, shall be made on the basis of full-time
7 equivalent student enrollment at the rate of \$4,400 per student.

8 Section 3. The university shall provide such information and
9 in such form and manner as the Department of Education may
10 prescribe.

11 Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall reports its
12 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
13 as required under the provisions of this act in accordance with
14 generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for
15 educational institutions as set forth in the "Industry Audit
16 Guide for Colleges and Universities" of the American Institute
17 of Certified Public Accountants of 1973, without exception.

18 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
