## A SUPPLEMENT

- To the act of June 4, 1976 (No.7-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial 2 3 Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining 5 unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 6 7 1976," itemizing appropriations required from the Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several 8 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor 9 10 License Fund moneys. 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. 25	act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any
26	other source as contributions to or payments for the programs
27	provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and
28	are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the
29	purposes and programs intended.
30	Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
