REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, JUNE 14, 1976

A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of June 4, 1976 (No.7-A), entitled "An act to provide
2 for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial
3 Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the
4 public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30,
5 1977, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining
6 unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30,
7 1976," itemizing appropriations required from the Motor
8 License Fund for the proper operation of the several
9 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor
10 License Fund moneys.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15 Appropriation Act of 1976."

16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for

5	For payment from the restricted revenue accounts		
6	for aviation fuel taxes and airport operations		
7	revenue, for aviation operations including the

11	State airports and the maintenance and repair of		
12	landing fields, intermediate landing fields, landing		
13	field equipment, beacon sites, other navigation

17	Bridge Authority for projects constructed with

2 No more shall be expended from this item for
3 such purpose or any of them than may be required
4 to match an equal sum contributed by any political
5 subdivision, or municipality authority of the
6 Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by
7 a political subdivision or municipality authority
8 and the Federal Government as provided in the act
9 of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136, No.56), relating to
10 Federal aid for airports.

11 To the Treasury Department

12 For the payment of replacement checks issued in
13 lieu of outstanding checks when presented and to
14 adjust errors..... 50,000

15 For payment of the compensation of the Common-
16 wealth's Loan and Transfer Agent for services and
17 expenses in connection with the registration,
18 transfer and payment of interest on bonds of the
19 Commonwealth and other services required to be
20 performed by the Loan and Transfer Agent..... 100,000

21 For payment of refunds of liquid fuels taxes
22 for agricultural use to which the Commonwealth
23 is not entitled..... 5,500,000

24 For the payment of approved claims for the
25 refunding of liquid fuels taxes and fuel use taxes
26 to which the Commonwealth is not entitled..... 5,000,000

27 For the payment of salaries, wages and all
28 necessary expenses in the proper administration of
29 the program to refund liquid fuels taxes for agri-
30 cultural use to which the Commonwealth is not

3	refunding of emergency liquid fuels tax moneys to

22	companies, volunteer ambulance services and

24	For the payment of salaries, wages and all	
25	necessary expenses for the proper administration	
26	of the refunding of liquid fuels tax - volunteer	
27	fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and	
28	volunteer rescue squads.....	45,000
29	For the payment of interest on tax anticipation

 2 cost of engraving and other expenses incurred in

 4 To the Department of Education
 5 For administration of the school safe driving
 6 program, and for payments to school districts or
 7 joint school organizations for driver education
 8 courses..... 4,441,000
 9 To the Department of General Services
 10 For the payment of rental charges to The
 11 General State Authority..... 1,543,000
 12 To the Department of Revenue
 13 For the proper administration and enforcement
 14 of the regulations under "The Liquid Fuels Tax
 15 Act," "Motor Carriers Road Tax
 16 Act," and "Bus Compact"..... 3,276,000
 17 To the Pennsylvania State Police
 18 For transfer to the General Fund to finance the
 19 traffic control and the traffic safety facilities
 20 program of the Pennsylvania State Police..... 83,484,000
 21 For transfer to the General Fund to finance
 22 the Municipal Police Officers Education and
 23 Training Commission..... 1,400,000
 24 Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this
 25 act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any
 26 other source as contributions to or payments for the programs
 27 provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and
 28 are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the
 29 purposes and programs intended.

30 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
