AN ACT

Amending the act of May 11, 1949 (P.L.1210, No.367), entitled "An act relating to group life insurance; describing 3 permitted policies and restrictions thereon, the premium basis thereof and rights thereunder; limiting the amount of 5 such insurance; prescribing standard policy provisions; and 6 requiring notice of conversion privileges, permitting group 7 life insurance coverage of the spouse and one or more 8 dependent children of the employe or member of the insured group; and limiting the amount of such insurance. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1, act of May 11, 1949 (P.L.1210, 12 13 No.367), entitled "An act relating to group life insurance; describing permitted policies and restrictions thereon, the 14 premium basis thereof and rights thereunder; limiting the amount 15 16 of such insurance; prescribing standard policy provisions; and requiring notice of conversion privileges," is amended by adding 17 a clause to read: 18 19 Section 1. Types Permitted. -- No policy of group life 20 insurance shall be delivered in this State unless it conforms to 21 one of the following descriptions and to the requirements as to

- 1 each set forth in sections two, three, four and five of this
- 2 act.

- 4 (7) A policy issued in accordance with clause (1), (3), (4)
- 5 or (5) of this section may include provisions for the payment by
- 6 the insurer of life insurance benefits upon the death of the
- 7 spouse of the insured employe or member, and upon the death of
- 8 one or more of his or her children dependent upon him or her for
- 9 <u>support and maintenance: Provided, however, That such insurance</u>
- 10 upon the life of the spouse shall not exceed five thousand
- 11 dollars (\$5,000) or one-half of the amount of insurance on the
- 12 <u>life of the insured employe or member as provided in such</u>
- 13 policy, whichever is less, and such insurance upon the life of
- 14 each dependent child shall not exceed one thousand dollars
- 15 (\$1,000).
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
