## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled 2
  - "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
- 3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
- providing for certain military service credit for employe
- 5 retirement other than city-paid firemen and police.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 4350, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, 8
- No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and
- 10 amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:
- Section 4350. Computation of Time of Service; Military 11
- 12 <u>Credit.--(a)</u> The time of service herein specified, namely,
- 13 [twenty] ten years, shall be computed from the time of the first
- 14 or original employments, said employment to consist of service
- 15 to the city and need not be continuous.
- (b) With the approval of council, all members of the pension 16
- 17 fund who are contributors and who served in the armed forces of
- the United States subsequent to September 1, 1940, and who were 18
- not members of the pension fund prior to such military service, 19
- shall be entitled to have full service credit for each year or 20

- 1 fraction thereof, not to exceed five years of such service upon
- 2 their payment to the pension fund of an amount equal to that
- 3 which they would have paid had they been members during the
- 4 period for which they desire credit, and their payment to such
- 5 <u>fund of an additional amount as the equivalent of the</u>
- 6 contributions of the city plus any interest the city would have
- 7 been required to pay on the contributions on account of such
- 8 <u>military service: Provided, That the member has three years of</u>
- 9 city service subsequent to such military service: Provided,
- 10 further, That he is not entitled to receive, eligible to receive
- 11 now or in the future, or is receiving retirement benefits for
- 12 <u>such service under a retirement system administered and wholly</u>
- 13 or partially paid for by any other governmental agency.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
