# HOUSE BILL No. 549 semm 1977 

INTRODUCED BY DOMBROWSKI, DiCARLO, LAUDADIO, VALICENTI AND KOLTER, MARCH 7, 1977

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON FINANCE, MARCH 7, 1977

## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, authorizing the use in clubs of games of chance registered with the Department of Revenue and providing for their registration upon payment of an annual registration fee, and tax, to be paid into the state Lottery Fund for the purpose of providing property tax relief for the elderly and local transit for the elderly.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 5513 of Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is amended by adding subsections to read:
§ 5513. Gambling devices, gambling, etc.

(c) Exception.--Subsections (a) and (b) shall not apply to games of chance which are registered in accordance with subsection (d) for use by clubs on premises occupied by such clubs.
(d) Registration of games of chance.--A game of chance machine shall be registered with the Pennsylvania Department of

Revenue upon payment of an annual registration fee of $\$ 500$, the payment of which shall be evidenced by a registration stamp issued by the department and affixed to the game of chance machine. Registration shall be for a calendar year and fees for initial registration filed during a calendar year shall be reduced to an amount proportionate to the number of months remaining in the year. The department shall adopt forms and procedures for application for registration stamps except that, in addition to other requirements of the department, the application for registration shall contain the name of the manufacturer and the name and address of the owner of the game of chance machine and the registration stamp shall contain the serial or other identification number of the game of chance machine and the registration expiration date. The fees collected by the Department of Revenue shall be paid into the State Lottery Fund and shall be allocated for the purpose of providing property tax relief for the elderly pursuant to the provisions of the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), known as the "Senior Citizens Property Tax or Rent Rebate Act," and for the purpose of providing local transit for the elderly pursuant to the act of January 22, 1968 (P.L. 42, No. 8), known as the "Pennsylvania Urban Mass Transportation Assistance Law of 1967."
(e) Imposition of tax.--There is hereby imposed a tax of $15 \%$ of the net profits realized on each game of chance machine. This tax shall be paid into the State Lottery Fund for the purpose of providing property tax relief for the elderly pursuant to the provisions of the "Senior Citizens Property Tax or Rent Rebate Act," and for the purpose of local transit of the elderly pursuant to the "Pennsylvania Urban Mass Transportation
Assistance Law of 1967."
are registered in accordance with the provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 5513 (relating to gambling devices, gambling, etc.).

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
