AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 7 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections, requiring additional information to be included 11 12 on expense accounts. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- hereby enacts as follows: 14
- 15 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 1607, act of June 3,
- 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election
- Code, " amended July 1, 1976 (No.124), is amended to read: 17
- 18 Section 1607. Expense Accounts to Be Filed. --
- 19 Every candidate for nomination or election, and every
- 20 treasurer of a political committee, or person acting as such
- 21 treasurer, shall, within thirty days after every primary and

- 1 election at which such candidate was voted for or with which
- 2 such political committee was concerned, if the amount received
- 3 or expended or liabilities incurred shall exceed the sum of one
- 4 hundred fifty dollars, file a full, true and detailed account,
- 5 subscribed and sworn to by him, setting forth each and every sum
- 6 of money received, contributed or disbursed by him for primary
- 7 or election expenses, the date of each receipt, contribution and
- 8 disbursement, the full name, home address, business address and
- 9 <u>occupation</u> of the person from whom received or to whom paid, and
- 10 the specific object or purpose for which the same was disbursed.
- 11 AS TO CONTRIBUTORS, THE ACCOUNT SHALL INCLUDE THE PERSON'S FIRST <----
- 12 AND LAST NAME, HOME ADDRESS AND, IF APPLICABLE, OCCUPATION AND
- 13 EMPLOYER. Where the person from whom the money was received or

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- 14 contributed is CONTRIBUTION IS FROM A PERSON other than an
- 15 individual, ONLY the full name, date and address shall be set
- 16 forth. Such account shall also set forth the unpaid debts and
- 17 liabilities of any such candidate or committee for primary or
- 18 election expenses, with the nature and amount of each, and to
- 19 whom owing. In the case of the treasurer of a political
- 20 committee, the account shall include any unexpended balance of
- 21 contributions or other receipts appearing from the last previous
- 22 account filed by him, and shall also include a complete listing
- 23 of all receipts and disbursements made by such committee for any
- 24 purpose, including all receipts and disbursements from the
- 25 publication and sale of all publications, and from the time of
- 26 the last account or from the time of the formation of the
- 27 political committee if no prior account has been filed. In the
- 28 case of candidates for election who have previously filed
- 29 accounts of their primary expenses as candidates for nomination,
- 30 the accounts shall only include receipts, contributions and

- 1 disbursements subsequent to the date of such prior accounts.
- 2 Notwithstanding the foregoing paragraph, where any amount
- 3 received or contributed is not more than fifty (\$50) dollars,
- 4 such amounts may be aggregated according to the date of receipt
- 5 or contribution. In such cases, the name of the person from whom
- 6 received or contributed need not be set forth. However, where
- 7 the candidate for nomination or election, treasurer of a
- 8 political committee, or person acting as a treasurer, knows or
- 9 has reason to know that a person has, through multiple
- 10 contributions, contributed more than a total of fifty (\$50)
- 11 dollars, he must make a full, true and detailed account and
- 12 report of what he knows or has reason to know.
