14	RemovalThe Commonwealth and its political subdivisions shall
15	use salt or other chemicals to remove snow and ice only on
16	hills, at intersections and on high speed or arterial highways
17	where traction is critical and only whenever, within a
18	reasonable time after the accumulation of the snow and ice, the
19	removal thereof or the reduction of the hazardous conditions
20	created thereby can be accomplished by blading, sanding and the
21	use of chemicals to permit the free flow of sand or natural

## 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
