- 4 The General Assembly states the estimated useful life of the

- 8 Section 6. Appropriation.
- 9 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein
- 10 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 11 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount
- 12 of \$163,540,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the
- 13 financial cost of the public improvement projects specifically
- 14 itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or paying the
