- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, making self-defense an affirmative
- defense.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 505 of Title 18, act of November 25, 1970
- 7 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 505. Use of force in self-protection.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (d) Self-defense an affirmative defense. -- The use of force
- 12 in self-protection under this section is a defense if the
- 13 <u>defendant being prosecuted proves by a preponderance of the</u>
- 14 evidence that the force with which he protected himself from
- 15 another was necessary and justifiable.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
