AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled 2 "An act relating to the finances of the State government; providing for the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, bonus, and all other accounts due the 3 4 5 Commonwealth, the collection and recovery of fees and other 6 money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or 7 any agency thereof, including escheated property and the 8 proceeds of its sale, the custody and disbursement or other 9 disposition of funds and securities belonging to or in the 10 possession of the Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and 11 appeals to the courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to 12 13 the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth 14 and all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 15 16 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth and 17 imposing penalties; affecting every department, board, 18 commission, and officer of the State government, every 19 political subdivision of the State, and certain officers of 20 such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation 21 required to pay, assess, or collect taxes, or to make returns 22 or reports under the laws imposing taxes for State purposes, 23 or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, 24 or any agency thereof, every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the Commonwealth, " requiring funds of 25 State institutions to be deposited within the Commonwealth. 26

- 27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 28 hereby enacts as follows:
- 29 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
- 30 as "The Fiscal Code," is amended by adding a section to read:

- 1 <u>Section 302.1.</u> <u>Deposits of Funds of State Institutions.--All</u>
- 2 moneys of institutions owned, maintained or operated by the
- 3 <u>Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the moneys of ancillary and</u>
- 4 complementary organizations thereto, shall, when deposited, be
- 5 <u>deposited only in a financial institution approved by the Board</u>
- 6 of Finance and Revenue having an office for the transaction of
- 7 financial business within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
