A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an emergency constitutional amendment to the
- 2 Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, granting
- 3 the General Assembly the power to enact special laws to aid
- 4 certain individuals, corporations, associations, institutions
- or nonpublic schools adversely affected by conditions caused
- 6 by certain storms or floods.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby resolves as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 10 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 11 the emergency provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 12 That section 17, Article VIII be amended to read:
- 13 § 17. Special emergency legislation.
- 14 Notwithstanding any provisions of this Constitution to the
- 15 contrary, the General Assembly shall have the authority to enact
- 16 laws providing for tax rebates, credits, exemptions, grants-in-
- 17 aid, State supplementations, or otherwise provide special
- 18 provisions for individuals, corporations, associations or
- 19 nonprofit institutions, including nonpublic schools (whether
- 20 sectarian or nonsectarian) in order to alleviate the danger,

- 1 damage, suffering or hardship faced by such individuals,
- 2 corporations, associations, institutions or nonpublic schools as
- 3 a result of Great Storms or Floods of September 1971, or June
- 4 1972, or of 1974, or of 1975 or of 1977.
- 5 Section 2. This proposed amendment shall be submitted by the
- 6 Secretary of the Commonwealth to the qualified electors of the
- 7 State, at the primary, municipal or general election next held
- 8 after the advertising requirements of section 1, Article XI of
- 9 the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania have been
- 10 satisfied.
