16	Enabling a [married woman,] spouse, who has been deserted,
17	abandoned, or driven from [her] home by [her husband,] the
18	other spouse, to sue [her husband,] the other spouse, upon
19	any cause of action whatsoever; and making such [wife] spouse
20	a competent witness against the [husband] other spouse in

- 2 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That from and after the
- 3 passage of this act, any [wife,] spouse, who has been deserted,
- 4 abandoned, or driven from [her] home by [her husband,] the other
- 5 spouse, may sue [her husband] the other spouse civilly, in any
- 6 court of this Commonwealth having the jurisdiction, upon any
- 7 cause of action now existing or hereafter accruing, [with like
- 8 effect as if such wife were a feme sole;] and in such case the
- 9 [wife] plaintiff spouse shall be a competent witness against the
- 10 [husband:] other spouse: Provided, however, That nothing in this
- 11 act contained shall be deemed to destroy the right of
- 12 survivorship in any land heretofore or hereafter conveyed to
- 13 such wife and husband jointly.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
