8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 2001, act of July 28,
10	1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code,"
11	is amended to read:
12	Section 2001. County Commissioners to Make ContractsThe
13	County Commissioners may make contracts for lawful purposes and
14	for the purposes of carrying into execution the provisions of
15	this section and the laws of the Commonwealth.

17	(c) The successful bidder, when advertising is required
18	herein, shall be required to furnish a bond with suitable
19	reasonable requirements guaranteeing performance of the
20	contract, with sufficient surety in the amount of fifty per

1 centum (50%) of the amount of the contract[, within twenty (20) 2 days after the contract has been awarded, unless the 3 commissioners shall prescribe a shorter period of not less than ten (10) days, and upon failure to furnish such bond within such 4 5 time, the previous awards shall be void]. Deliveries, accomplishment and guarantees may be required in all cases of 6 7 expenditures, including the exceptions herein. * * * 8

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
