1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," further providing for candidates for political office.

15	Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
16	as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended by adding a

18	Section 951.1. Limitations on Eligibility of Candidates
19	Any person who is a registered and enrolled member of a party or
20	January 15 is ineligible to be a candidate of a political body
21	in an election in the same year.
22	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
