## AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing prescriptions at nominal charge to senior citizens.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Definitions.
- 5 As used in this act unless the context clearly indicates
- otherwise, shall have the following meaning: 6
- 7 "Department." The Department of Revenue.
- 8 "Senior citizens." Every person who is sixty-five years of
- age or older.
- 10 Section 2. Prescriptions.
- 11 Every senior citizen whose income from all sources is less
- 12 than \$9,000 or if married whose combined income is less than
- \$13,000 shall be eligible to receive prescriptions at a charge 13
- 14 of \$1.00 for each prescription.
- 15 Section 3. Department's duties.
- 16 The department shall administer this act. The department
- shall prepare application forms and identification cards and 17
- 18 shall have the authority to adopt rules and regulations in

- 1 carrying out the provisions of this act.
- 2 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days. 3
