1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, authorizing the court to order the forfeiture of certain retirement benefits and for the attachment and assignment of certain funds.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Chapter 11 of Title 18, act of November 25, 1970
8	(P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes, is amended by adding a section to read:
10	<u>§ 1107. Actions against retirement benefits.</u>
11	(a) Forfeiture of benefitsAny officer or employee of the
12	Commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions, agencies or
13	authorities who, in connection with their official duties as an
14	officer or employee breaks their contract with the governmental
15	unit by committing any felony or misdemeanor involving
16	misbehavior in office or employment and who is convicted
17	thereof, shall be sentenced to forfeit any right to receive
18	public pension or annuity benefits to which such person would
19	<u>otherwise have been entitled.</u>

1	(b) Garnishment and attachment of contributionsIn	
2	addition to the forfeiture of benefits authorized pursuant to	
3	subsection (a), the salary contributions of any such officer or	
4	employee shall be subject to garnishment and attachment by the	
5	court to offset the imposition of any fine or penalty imposed or	
6	to provide restitution to the governmental unit for the value of	
7	any property or funds stolen, misused or misallocated by the	
8	<u>officer or employee.</u>	
9	(c) Return of salary contributions and interestExcept as	
10	provided in subsection (b), any person convicted subject to the	
11	conditions enumerated in subsection (a) shall be entitled to the	
12	return of his salary contributions and statutory interest	
13	thereon. However, before any payment of such contributions and	
14	interest is made by any individual, agency or board having such	
15	responsibility, the sentencing court shall certify that the	
16	individual who has forfeited his benefits pursuant to subsection	
17	(a) is not subject to the attachment and garnishment provisions	
18	of subsection (b).	
19	(d) Acquittal on appealIf the conviction of the	
20	individual is reversed on appeal and the individual is	
21	ultimately acquitted, his pension or annuity rights and any	
22	attached or garnished contributions and interest thereon shall	
23	be retroactively restored as existing on the date of the initial	
24	conviction.	
25	(e) DefinitionsAs used in this section:	
26	"Conviction." Initial conviction by a court of record and	
27	includes pleas of guilty and nolo contendere.	
28	"Contract." An explicit or implied agreement which shall be	
29	deemed to be terminated and renewed each time an officer or	
30	employee is elected, appointed, promoted or otherwise changes a
