1 WHEREAS, The act of December 30, 1974 (P.L.1037, No.338),
2 provided for the observance of January 15 of each year as Martin
3 Luther King Day; and

4 WHEREAS, Contribution and sacrifice of this dedicated
5 American must be always before us; and

6 WHEREAS, It is appropriate for the General Assembly to renew
7 its dedication to the ideals he represented; therefore be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
9 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania observes January 15, 1977 as Martin
10 Luther King Day to commemorate the life and the services to the
11 country and his fellow citizens of the Reverend Doctor Martin
12 Luther King, Jr.
