## HOUSE RESOLUTION No. 11 Session of 1977

INTRODUCED BY ZITTERMAN, ZELLER, SWEET, DeWEESE, BITTINGER AND GATSKI, FEBRUARY 7, 1977

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, FEBRUARY 7, 1977

In the House of Representatives, February 7, 1977 1 WHEREAS, Much public outcry has been raised over the recent 2 Federal Court's ruling affecting State Police hiring and 3 promotion regulations; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives 5 appoint a seven member bipartisan committee, four from the 6 majority party and three from the minority party to conduct a 7 complete investigation of the entire matter of the alleged 8 reverse discrimination regarding the court-ordered procedures; 9 and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take testimony, and make its investigations at such places as it 11 12 deems necessary. It may issue subpoenas under the hand and seal 13 of its chairman commanding any person to appear before it and to 14 answer questions touching matters properly being inquired into 15 by the committee and to produce such books, papers, records and 16 documents as the committee deems necessary. Such subpoenas may be served upon any person and shall have the force and effect of 17

subpoenas issued out of the courts of this Commonwealth. Any person who willfully neglects or refuses to testify before the committee or to produce any books, papers, records or documents, shall be subject to the penalties provided by the laws of the Commonwealth in such case. Each member of the committee shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That within 30 calendar days after the committee has made its report, the chairman of the committee shall cause a 9 10 record of all expenses incurred by the committee, or the members 11 thereof, which are payable at Commonwealth expense, to be filed with the Speaker of the House and the Speaker shall cause the 12 13 same to be entered in the journal thereof. No expenses incurred by the committee or any member thereof shall be reimbursable by 14 15 the Chief Clerk unless such expense shall first have been 16 included as an expense item in the record heretofore required; 17 and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That the committee shall report its findings, 19 together with its recommendations, for appropriate legislation 20 or otherwise to the General Assembly as soon as the 21 investigation and study are completed or at the end of the 22 session, whichever is sooner.
