1 WHEREAS, The United States Senate is currently considering a
2 proposal to abolish the Senate Veterans Affairs Committee; and

3 WHEREAS, The veterans of this country have special problems
4 and needs that cannot be lumped together and lost in a
5 bureaucratic shuffle; therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
7 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorializes the Congress of the
8 United States to oppose the abolition of the Senate Veterans
9 Affairs Committee; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
11 the President of the United States, the Speaker of the United
12 States House of Representatives, the President pro tempore of
13 the United States Senate and to each Senator and Representative
14 from Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United States.
