In the House of Representatives, September 11, 1978

1       It has come to the attention of many members of the General  
2       Assembly that the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Fund is  
3       indebted to the Federal Government for large sums of money and  
4       at the present time there does not seem to be any way to reduce  
5       or eliminate this indebtedness.

6       Suggestions should be made to the General Assembly as to how  
7       this large debt can be repaid or at least reduced. These  
8       suggestions and recommendations would most likely come from an  
9       investigation of the fund and its operation; therefore be it

10       RESOLVED, That the House Committee on Labor Relations be  
11       directed to examine the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation  
12       Fund and its operations with an aim toward reducing or  
13       eliminating its indebtedness to the Federal Government; and be  
14       it further

15       RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and  
16       recommendations to the General Assembly as soon as possible.
