- 1 It has come to the attention of many members of the General
- 2 Assembly that the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Fund is
- 3 indebted to the Federal Government for large sums of money and
- 4 at the present time there does not seem to be any way to reduce
- 5 or eliminate this indebtedness.
- 6 Suggestions should be made to the General Assembly as to how
- 7 this large debt can be repaid or at least reduced. These
- 8 suggestions and recommendations would most likely come from an
- 9 investigation of the fund and its operation; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House Committee on Labor Relations be
- 11 directed to examine the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation
- 12 Fund and its operations with an aim toward reducing or
- 13 eliminating its indebtedness to the Federal Government; and be
- 14 it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and
- 16 recommendations to the General Assembly as soon as possible.
