AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 1, 1965 (P.L.988, No.368),
2 entitled, as amended, "An act relating to weights and
3 measures; regulating the use and sale, and providing for the
4 inspection of weighing and measuring devices; regulating the
5 sale and packaging of commodities; imposing duties and
6 conferring powers upon the Attorney General and Department of
7 Justice and certain local officials; and prescribing
8 penalties," providing for the disposition of fines.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. The act of December 1, 1965 (P.L.988, No.368),
12 known as the "Weights and Measures Act of 1965," is amended by
13 adding a section to read:

14 Section 36.1. Disposition of Fines.--All fines collected
15 under this act shall be paid to the Secretary of Agriculture of
16 the Department of Agriculture of this Commonwealth, or his
17 agent, and by him shall be paid into the State Treasury for the
18 use of the Commonwealth.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
