AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
4 providing for certain military service credit for employe
5 retirement other than city-paid firemen and police.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 4350, act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932,
9 No.317), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and
10 amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:

11 Section 4350. Computation of Time of Service; Military
12 Credit.--(a) The time of service herein specified, namely,
13 [twenty] ten years, shall be computed from the time of the first
14 or original employments, said employment to consist of service
15 to the city and need not be continuous.

16 (b) With the approval of council, all members of the pension
17 fund who are contributors and who served in the armed forces of
18 the United States subsequent to September 1, 1940, and who were
19 not members of the pension fund prior to such military service,

1 shall be entitled to have full service credit for each year or
2 fraction thereof, not to exceed five years of such service upon
3 their payment to the pension fund of an amount equal to that
4 which they would have paid had they been members during the
5 period for which they desire credit, and their payment to such
6 fund of an additional amount as the equivalent of the
7 contributions of the city plus any interest the city would have
8 been required to pay on the contributions on account of such
9 military service: Provided, That the member has three years of
10 city service subsequent to such military service: Provided
11 further, That he is not entitled to receive, eligible to receive
12 now or in the future, or is receiving retirement benefits for
13 such service under a retirement system administered and wholly
14 or partially paid for by any other governmental agency.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
