AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Requiring political subdivisions, municipal corporations, housing and redevelopment authorities to return a receipted copy of a public housing application to the applicant, and providing penalties.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Receipted copy of application.
8	Any political subdivision, municipal corporation, housing or
9	redevelopment authority which accepts applications for any form
10	of public housing shall, at the time of taking such application,
11	return a complete copy of same to the applicant. This copy shall
12	have indicated thereon the place, date and time of the taking of
13	the application.
14	Section 2. Copy as evidence.
15	A copy of an application shall be prima facia evidence of its
16	acceptance by the political subdivision, municipal corporation,
17	housing or redevelopment authority at the place, date and time
18	stated thereon.
19	Section 3. Penalty.

Any officer, agent or employee of a political subdivision, 1 2 municipal corporation, housing or redevelopment authority who 3 fails or refuses to give a copy of an application to an applicant as provided in section 1, or who fraudulently 4 5 backdates or postdates any application or otherwise fraudulently alters an application or creates a fictitious application shall, 6 upon conviction thereof at a summary proceeding, pay a fine of 7 8 \$300.

9 Section 4. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
