AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
4 thereto," providing for expense moneys in lieu of salary.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 703, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206,
8 No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and
9 amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), and amended November 9,
10 1977 (P.L.230, No.72), is amended to read:

11 Section 703. Compensation.--Each township commissioner shall
12 receive [a salary of] for expenses not more than eight hundred
13 dollars per year in townships having a population of less than
14 four thousand, not more than twelve hundred dollars per year in
15 townships having a population of four thousand and more but less
16 than ten thousand, not more than fifteen hundred dollars per
17 year in townships having a population of ten thousand and more
18 but less than fifteen thousand, not more than twenty-four
19 hundred dollars in townships having a population of not less

1 than fifteen thousand and not more than twenty-five thousand,
2 and not more than three thousand dollars in townships having a
3 population in excess of twenty-five thousand. Such [salaries]
4 expense moneys shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the
5 duties imposed by the provisions of this act.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
