AN ACT

Amending the act of July 19, 1957 (P.L.1017, No.451), entitled 2 "An act prohibiting advisors, consultants, officers and employes of the Commonwealth, the Pennsylvania Turnpike 3 Commission and State authorities, from having adverse 5 interests in certain contracts; prohibiting employes thereof from representing other persons in certain circumstances; and prescribing penalties, " redefining certain terms. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Clauses (5) and (6) of section 2, act of July 19, 11 1957 (P.L.1017, No.451), known as the "State Adverse Interest 12 Act," are amended to read: 13 Section 2. The following terms shall have the following meanings, when used in this act: 14 15 16 (5) "Contract." A contract or arrangement for the 17 acquisition, use or disposal by a State agency of services or of 18 supplies, materials, equipment, land or other personal or real 19 property. The term "contract" shall not mean an agreement

between the Commonwealth or a State agency as one party and [a

- 1 State advisor, consultant or employe] another State agency,
- 2 political subdivision or instrumentality of the State as the
- 3 other party. <u>It shall not mean an agreement between the</u>
- 4 Commonwealth or a State agency as one party and a State advisor,
- 5 consultant, or employe as the other party, concerning his
- 6 expense, reimbursement, fee, salary, wage, retirement benefit,
- 7 tenure or other matters touching his personal service to the
- 8 Commonwealth or State agency.
- 9 (6) "Have an Adverse Interest." Be the party to a contract,
- 10 as herein defined, other than the Commonwealth or a State agency
- 11 or be a stockholder, partner, member, agent, representative or
- 12 employe of such party except that this definition shall not
- 13 apply where it can be shown that no personal pecuniary gain will
- 14 result by being a party to a contract, as defined in this
- 15 section.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
