## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled "An 2 act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages for 3 injuries received by an employe in the course of employment; establishing an elective schedule of compensation; providing 5 procedure for the determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and prescribing penalties, "increasing certain 7 compensation rates. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Clause (h) of section 306, act of June 2, 1915 11 (P.L.736, No.338), known as "The Pennsylvania Workmen's 12 Compensation Act, " reenacted and amended June 21, 1939 (P.L.520, 13 No.281) and added December 5, 1974 (P.L.782, No.263), is amended 14 to read: 15 Section 306. The following schedule of compensation is 16 hereby established: 17 18 (h) Any person receiving compensation under sections 306(a), 306(b), 306(c)(23), or section 307, as a result of an accident 19 which occurred prior to [the effective date of the amendatory 20 21 act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.6, No.4)] January 1, 1973 shall

- 1 have the compensation rate adjusted to the level they would have
- 2 received had the injury occurred on [the effective date of the
- 3 amendatory act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.6, No.4)] January 1,
- 4 1973 and had the injured employe been earning wages equal to
- 5 [ninety dollars (\$90)] one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per
- 6 week. The additional compensation shall be paid by the self-
- 7 insured employer or insurance carrier making payment and shall
- 8 be reimbursed in advance by the Commonwealth on a quarterly
- 9 basis as provided in rules and regulations of the department.
- 10 The payment of additional compensation shall be made by the
- 11 carrier or self-insured employer only during those fiscal years
- 12 for which appropriations are made to cover reimbursement.
- 13 Section 2. (a) This act shall take effect immediately.
- 14 (b) The increase in compensation payments provided for
- 15 herein shall commence on July 1 next following the date of final
- 16 enactment of this amendatory act, provided an appropriation has
- 17 been made to cover the increase in reimbursements necessary for
- 18 such increase in compensation payments.
