## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled 2 "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto, " requiring a fluorescent orange 4 color to be worn by hunters when hunting certain animals and providing a penalty. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), known 10 as "The Game Law," is amended by adding a section to read: 11 Section 707.1. Clothing or Material Worn While Hunting 12 Certain Game; Penalty for Violation. -- (a) Whoever during the open season on deer, bear or woodchucks shall enter any 13 14 woodlands or fields within the Commonwealth for the purpose of 15 hunting or assisting to hunt for the same shall wear or display 16 in a conspicuous manner on his head, <del>chest and</del> OR CHEST OR back combined, a minimum of two hundred fifty ONE HUNDRED TWENTY 17 18 square inches of clothing or material of a daylight fluorescent

orange color with a dominant wave length between five hundred

- 1 ninety-five and six hundred five nanometers, an excitation
- 2 purity of not less than eighty-five per centum and a luminance
- 3 factor of not less than forty per centum: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, <---
- 4 THAT WHEN HUNTING FOR WOODCHUCK THE CLOTH OR MATERIAL OF
- 5 FLUORESCENT ORANGE COLOR SHALL BE WORN ON THE HEAD.
- 6 (b) Any ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER 1, 1981, ANY person violating <---
- 7 any provision of this section shall upon conviction, be
- 8 sentenced to pay a fine of twenty dollars (\$20.00) and costs of
- 9 prosecution.
- 10 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to
- 11 hunters participating during a season in which only muzzle
- 12 <u>loading firearms or bows and arrows may be used.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect September 1, 1979
- 14 1980.
