AN ACT

1 Requiring the installation of nonradioactive smoke-fire
2 detectors in all new home and apartment construction in
3 Pennsylvania.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. For all new home and apartment construction in
7 the Commonwealth, there shall be installed at least two smoke-
8 fire detectors of a nonradioactive type.

9 Section 2. The responsibility for such installation shall be
10 the builder of the structure.

11 Section 3. Violations of this act shall be a summary offense
12 punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50.

13 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
