## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, limiting legislative activities of the
- 3 General Assembly when annual appropriations are not enacted
- 4 three months before the beginning of the fiscal year.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 9 the provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 10 That section 11 of Article III be amended to read:
- 11 § 11. Appropriation bills.
- 12 (a) The general appropriation bill shall embrace nothing but
- 13 appropriations for the executive, legislative and judicial
- 14 departments of the Commonwealth, for the public debt and for
- 15 public schools. All other appropriations shall be made by
- 16 separate bills, each embracing but one subject.
- (b) If the General Assembly has not passed annual
- 18 appropriations for the ordinary and necessary expenses of the
- 19 Commonwealth prior to three months before the beginning of the

- 1 <u>next fiscal year the legislative activities of the General</u>
- 2 Assembly shall, beginning three months before the beginning of
- 3 the next fiscal year be restricted to matters concerning State
- 4 taxation and annual appropriations until appropriations for the
- 5 <u>ordinary and necessary expenses of the Commonwealth are enacted.</u>
- 6 (c) During the period in which legislative activities are
- 7 restricted under subsection (b), the members of the General
- 8 Assembly shall not receive any pay or allowances or be
- 9 reimbursed for any expenses.
