AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled
 - "An act providing for the payment of death benefits to the
- 3 surviving spouse or children of firemen or law enforcement
- 4 officers killed in the performance of their duties,"
- 5 including volunteer firemen within the act.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:

- 8 Section 1. Sections 1 and 2, act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424,
- 9 No.101), entitled "An act providing for the payment of death
- 10 benefits to the surviving spouse or children of firemen or law
- 11 enforcement officers killed in the performance of their duties,"
- 12 are amended to read:
- 13 Section 1. (a) A political subdivision shall pay to the
- 14 surviving spouse, or, if there is no surviving spouse, the minor
- 15 children, of a fireman, volunteer fireman or law enforcement
- 16 officer of the political subdivision killed in the performance
- 17 of his duties the sum of \$25,000. The benefit shall be payable
- 18 whether or not the officer was killed within the corporate
- 19 boundaries of the employing municipality.
- 20 (b) The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall pay to the

- 1 surviving spouse, or, if there is no surviving spouse, the minor
- 2 children of a State policeman or other law enforcement officer
- 3 of the Commonwealth killed in the performance of his duties the
- 4 sum of \$25,000. The benefit shall be payable whether or not the
- 5 officer was killed within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 6 (c) The political subdivision, or the surviving spouse, or a
- 7 guardian in fact or under the law for minor children may apply
- 8 to the State Treasurer of the Commonwealth for the death
- 9 benefit. No benefits or reimbursements shall be paid by the
- 10 State Treasurer until the Attorney General makes a
- 11 <u>determination</u>, that the beneficiary is eligible for the death
- 12 benefit.
- 13 Upon payment of this death benefit by a political
- 14 subdivision, the political subdivision shall apply to the State
- 15 Treasurer and upon a determination of the eligibility of the
- 16 <u>beneficiary for the death benefit</u>, be reimbursed for the total
- 17 amount by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Payments by the
- 18 Commonwealth or reimbursement to the political subdivisions
- 19 shall be made out of the General Fund of the Commonwealth of
- 20 Pennsylvania.
- 21 Section 2. "Fireman or law enforcement officer" means a
- 22 fireman, volunteer fireman, peace officer as defined in 18
- 23 Pa.C.S.§ 501 (relating to definitions), public servant concerned
- 24 in official detention as defined in 18 Pa.C.S.§ 5121 (relating
- 25 to escape), an officer or employee of a State correctional
- 26 institution, guards or employees of county jails and prisons or
- 27 other law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth of
- 28 Pennsylvania or of any political subdivision thereof.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
