Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "corporation." 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. The definition of "corporation" in section 102, of Title 66, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known 6 7 as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, added July 1, 1978 8 (No.116), is amended to read: § 102. Definitions. 9 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent provisions of this part which are applicable to specific 11 provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when 12 13 used in this part shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section: 14 15

16 "Corporation." All bodies corporate, joint-stock companies, 17 or associations, domestic or foreign, their lessees, assignees, 18 trustees, receivers, or other successors in interest, having any of the powers or privileges of corporations not possessed by
individuals or partnerships <u>including municipal corporations</u>,
but shall not include [municipal corporations, except as
otherwise expressly provided in this part, nor] bona fide
cooperative associations which furnish service on a nonprofit
basis only to their stockholders or members.

8 Section 2. The act of May 2, 1945 (P.L.382, No.164), known 9 as the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945," is repealed 10 insofar as inconsistent with this act.

11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
