14	(16) Any pharmacist, whether licensed or not, or any person
15	acting as a pharmacist, who makes false claims for payment shall
16	be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be
17	sentenced to pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), to
18	make restitution of any money gained through the false claim and
19	to a suspension or revocation of any license issued under this
20	act for such time as the court deems appropriate. The Attorney

- 1 General shall prosecute any person charged with making false
- 2 <u>claims for payment from public funds.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
