AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Commonwealth to impose license requirements on 2 all street sellers in cities of the first class; establishing
- 3 a license fee; imposing additional powers and duties on the
- 4 Department of Revenue; fixing a penalty and making an
- 5 appropriation.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Short title.
- 9 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Commonwealth
- 10 Street Seller's License Act."
- 11 Section 2. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 13 have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 14 meanings given to them in this section:
- 15 "Department." The Pennsylvania Department of Revenue.
- 16 "Display devices." Any motor vehicle or animal-pulled
- 17 vehicle, any other vehicle, wheeled cart, wagon, portable booth,
- 18 stand, table, shelves or other devices of a similar nature
- 19 utilized by street sellers to display items offered for sale.
- 20 "Items offered for sale." The term means and includes any

- 1 food, refreshments, dairy products, bakery products,
- 2 agricultural or horticultural products, clothing, jewelry,
- 3 trinkets or goods of any other nature.
- 4 "License." The Commonwealth Street Seller's License issued
- 5 by the department pursuant to section 3.
- 6 "Street seller." Any individual, limited partnership,
- 7 partnership, corporation or association who or which owns,
- 8 operates or leases to any other street seller any display
- 9 devices for the purpose of selling or offering for sale to the
- 10 general public on any street, sidewalk, alley, way, square or
- 11 any other area of public access, any food, dairy products,
- 12 bakery products, agricultural or horticultural products,
- 13 clothing, jewelry, trinkets or goods of any other nature.
- 14 Section 3. License.
- 15 (a) Ninety days after the effective date of the act, no
- 16 street seller in any city of the first class shall engage in
- 17 selling in such city unless or until said street seller has
- 18 obtained from the Department of Revenue an annual Commonwealth
- 19 Street Seller's License.
- 20 (b) Every application for a license shall be submitted to
- 21 the department. The application shall be in such form, contain
- 22 such information and be submitted in such manner as the
- 23 department shall establish by regulation.
- 24 (c) Every application for a new license or an annual license
- 25 renewal shall be accompanied by a fee of \$500 to be paid to the
- 26 department by certified check or money order.
- 27 (d) Every street seller who obtains a license shall
- 28 conspicuously display that license on his person or on the
- 29 display device utilized to show the general public the items
- 30 offered for sale.

- 1 Section 4. Powers and duties of the department.
- 2 The Department of Revenue shall have the following powers and
- 3 duties:
- 4 (1) Establish the form of the application and license
- 5 along with all pertinent information the department deems
- 6 necessary.
- 7 (2) Determine the specific items to be covered within
- 8 the general classes set forth in the definition.
- 9 (3) Determine the requisites necessary to conspicuously
- 10 display the license.
- 11 (4) Enforce the penalty provisions of this act.
- 12 (5) Do all things necessary to implement and administer
- 13 the provisions of this act.
- 14 Section 5. Penalty.
- Any street seller who violates the provisions of section 3(a)
- 16 or (d) shall upon conviction thereof be guilty of a misdemeanor
- 17 of the second degree and shall be sentenced to pay a fine of
- 18 \$5,000 and to surrender to the Commonwealth all display devices
- 19 and items offered for sale which were seized as evidence.
- 20 Section 6. Appropriation.
- 21 The sum of \$310,000 is hereby appropriated to the Department
- 22 of Revenue for the purpose of obtaining 20 new employees to
- 23 implement and enforce the provisions of this act.
- 24 Section 7. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
