10	Section 1. Section 1, act of July 12, 1935 (P.L.677,

14	amended March 26, 1957 (P.L.17, No.10), is amended to read:
15	Section 1. [Be it enacted, &c., That all] <u>All</u> officers and
16	employes of the Commonwealth [of Pennsylvania, or of any
17	political subdivision thereof,] or its instrumentalities, or any
18	political subdivision thereof, or its instrumentalities, who are
19	members, either enlisted or commissioned, of any reserve

component of the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard, shall be entitled to leave of absence from their respective duties without loss of pay, time, or efficiency rating on all days not exceeding fifteen in any one year during which they shall, as members of such reserve components, be engaged in the active service of the United States or in field training ordered or authorized by the Federal forces.
