14	Section 2. Powers of Governing BodyThe governing body of
15	every municipal corporation shall have the power:

17	(6) To appropriate and expend in accordance with the
18	specific provisions of the enabling ordinance such amounts as
19	may be necessary for the maintenance of such districts
20	including, but not limited to, the cleaning of streets,

1	sidewalks, rest areas, and other acquired property; repairs to
2	street lighting and other acquired improvements and security.
3	(7) To appropriate and expend in accordance with the
4	specific provisions of the enabling ordinance such amounts as
5	may be necessary for the administrative services of such
б	districts. Administrative services means those intangible
7	matters which improve the ability of the commercial activities
8	of the district to serve the consumer including, but not limited
9	to, free or reduced parking for customers, transportation
10	repayments, public relations programs, group advertising and
11	uniform credit policies.
12	Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
13	Section 5. Maintenance and Administrative Services Method of
14	Assessment(a) The total cost of the maintenance and
15	administrative services in such districts shall be assessed to
16	all of the benefited properties in the districts by the methods
17	provided in section 4(a).
18	(b) The governing body may by ordinance authorize the
19	payment of such assessment in equal annual, or more frequent
20	installments, over such time as set forth in the ordinance.

22	provided in section 4(c).
