AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled,
- 2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
- 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
- 4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, "
- 5 increasing the amount of money the board of commissioners may
- 6 appropriate for tourist promotion agencies.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1986, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323,
- 10 No.130), known as "The County Code" added August 13, 1963
- 11 (P.L.669, No.348), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 1986. Appropriations to Tourist Promotion
- 13 Agencies. -- The board of commissioners may appropriate, annually,
- 14 such amount of money but not in excess of [ten cents (10¢)]
- 15 thirty-five cents (35¢) for each resident of the county, as
- 16 determined by the last census, which may be deemed necessary to
- 17 any "tourist promotion agency" as defined in the act of April
- 18 28, 1961 (P.L.111, No.50), known as the "Tourist Promotion Law,"

- 1 to assist such agencies in carrying out tourist promotional
- 2 activities.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
