In the House of Representatives, March 13, 1979

- 1 WHEREAS, The Interstate Highway System is substantially
- 2 complete; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Federal aid highway tax revenues will be in excess
- 4 of amounts required for new highway construction; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Every state including Pennsylvania faces higher
- 6 maintenance costs for its portion of the interstate system;
- 7 therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 9 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of
- 10 the United States to amend the Federal Aid Highway Act so that
- 11 the maintenance of the Interstate Highway System will be funded
- 12 upon the basis of conditions of the Interstate Highway System
- 13 among the various states; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 15 the presiding officers of each House of the Congress of the
- 16 United States and to each Senator and Representative from
- 17 Pennsylvania in the Congress of the United States.
