In the House of Representatives, September 24, 1979

1 WHEREAS, The people of the Republic of China on Taiwan are
2 friends of the American people; and

3 WHEREAS, The United States of America and the Republic of
4 China on Taiwan have been bound for over 20 years by treaty; and

5 WHEREAS, The diplomatic recognition of the Peoples Republic
6 of China acknowledges the political and economic realities
7 existing on Mainland China as well as the relationship of the
8 United States of America to the Peoples Republic of China; and

9 WHEREAS, This diplomatic recognition may imperil the free
10 economic and political system of the people of Taiwan; therefore
11 be it

12 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
13 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress and
14 the President of the United States of America that the free
15 economic and political system of the People of Taiwan should
16 continue; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to the
2 presiding officers of the United States Congress and to each
3 Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania and to the
4 President of the United States.
