## AN ACT

7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Title 42, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
9	No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
10	amended by adding a section to read:
11	§ 8336. Immunity of victims of rape or
12	involuntary deviate sexual intercourse.
13	(a) Civil action prohibited No person convicted of the
14	crime of rape or involuntary deviate sexual intercourse shall
15	bring or maintain any action against his victim for any act or
16	omission relating to the offense for which he was convicted.
17	(b) Legal expenses The cost of all reasonable legal
18	expenses incurred by a victim in defending against a civil

action as described above shall be borne by the Commonwealth, if

- 1 the defendant is financially unable to bear the legal costs
- 2 relating to the action.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
