AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for emergency
- 3 preparedness planning.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 35, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding sections to read:
- 9 § 7315. Direct communications system.
- 10 To insure instant and continuous availability of direct
- 11 communications in case of emergency, the agency shall:
- 12 (1) Establish a 24-hour, direct telephone communications
- 13 system between the agency and each county emergency
- 14 management organization.
- 15 (2) Establish a 24-hour, direct telephone communications
- 16 system between the agency and each operating nuclear power
- 17 plant in the Commonwealth.

- 1 (3) Assist each county emergency preparedness
- 2 <u>organization establish a communications system between the</u>
- 3 school districts and the county organization or in the case
- 4 of multicounty school districts, between the school district
- 5 and the appropriate county organization as determined by the
- 6 <u>agency</u>.
- 7 § 7505. Coordinated disaster emergency management plans.
- 8 (a) Plans of political subdivisions. -- Pursuant to this
- 9 <u>subchapter</u>, <u>disaster emergency management plans prepared in</u>
- 10 accordance with section 7503(1) (relating to powers and duties
- 11 of political subdivisions) shall, except for counties, be
- 12 <u>submitted to the respective county emergency management</u>
- 13 <u>organizations</u>.
- 14 (b) County plans. -- Upon receipt of the plans submitted under
- 15 <u>subsection (a), counties shall prepare a county emergency</u>
- 16 management plan and submit such plan to the agency for inclusion
- 17 in the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Plan as provided in
- 18 section 7313 (relating to powers and duties).
- 19 Section 2. (a) This act shall take effect immediately.
- 20 (b) Plans of political subdivisions, other than counties,
- 21 shall be prepared and submitted to the respective county
- 22 emergency management organizations, pursuant to 35 Pa.C.S. §
- 23 7505(a), not later than 120 days from the date of final
- 24 enactment of this amendatory act.
- 25 (c) County plans shall be prepared and submitted to the
- 26 agency, pursuant to 35 Pa.C.S. § 7505(b), not later than six
- 27 months from the date of final enactment of this amendatory act.
