AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the maximum fine
- 3 to be imposed for summary offense convictions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1101 of Title 18, act of November 25,
- 7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes, is amended to read:
- 9 § 1101. Fines.
- 10 A person who has been convicted of an offense may be
- 11 sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding:
- 12 (1) \$25,000, when the conviction is of a felony of the
- 13 first or second degree.
- 14 (2) \$15,000, when the conviction is of a felony of the
- 15 third degree.
- 16 (3) \$10,000, when the conviction is of a misdemeanor of
- 17 the first degree.
- 18 (4) \$5,000, when the conviction is of a misdemeanor of

- 1 the second degree.
- 2 (5) \$2,500, when the conviction is of a misdemeanor of
- 3 the third degree.
- 4 (6) [\$300] \$600, when the conviction is of a summary
- offense.
- 6 (7) Any higher amount equal to double the pecuniary gain
- 7 derived from the offense by the offender.
- 8 (8) Any higher or lower amount specifically authorized
- 9 by statute.
- 10 Section 2. The provisions of this amendatory act shall apply
- 11 to all convictions for summary offenses which are committed on
- 12 or after the effective date of this act.
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
