## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing appropriations for citizens' band radio base stations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.

The board shall have power--

LXXV. Appropriation for Citizens' Band Radio Base Station.

To appropriate funds for the establishment of a township
citizens' band radio base station for public service, nonprofit
use. Not more than one thousand dollars shall be appropriated
annually for radio equipment and not more than twelve hundred dollars shall be appropriated annually for rental of facilities to house the equipment in the event no space is available in existing public building.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
