21 April 28, 1943 (P.L.123, No.63), is amended to read:

22 Section 9. The assistants to the Pennsylvania State Police,

23 not receiving a salary for the performance of public duties,

24 shall receive, upon the audit of the Pennsylvania State Police,

[fifty cents] two dollars (\$2.00) for each report of each 1 2 separate fire reported to the Pennsylvania State Police under 3 this act, and, in addition thereto, shall be paid the sum of fifteen cents for each mile traveled to and from the place of 4 5 fire and, in the discretion of the Pennsylvania State Police, where an investigation has been made, a sum not to exceed [three 6 7 dollars (\$3.00)] ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day's service 8 spent in such investigation.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
